Number and Place Value

Addition and Subtraction

This term, we will begin by consolidating our knowledge of place value. We will be using the terminology of more, less than and equal to to compare different numbers, their quantities and we will begin writing them in words. We will also look at ordering and sorting numbers, focussing mainly on numbers 1 to 10.

We will then be learning our number bonds to 10 through problem solving, addition and subtraction games and songs.

Families and Belonging

This term, we will begin by discussing what a family is, what they do, why they are important and how they are both similar and different to others. Following this, we will discuss why a feeling of belonging is important, what different groups we belong to and how we all belong to the family of God.

English

Traditional Tales

Our theme this term will be The Three Little Pigs. We will look closely at this story, its content, structure and key criteria in order to compare this story to other traditional tales. We will look closely at the different characters of the story and how they make the story more appealing. At the end of this topic, the children will attempt to write their own version of The Three Little Pigs, alternating characters and settings as they wish.

In addition to their main English lesson, the children will receive a daily phonics lesson in which they will learn letter and sound recognition in order to support their reading.

Year One

The Three Little Pigs

Topic

During the topic of the three little pigs, we will be looking at the different toys and games children used to play in the past. We will look at older children's shows and productions and compare them to our current toys, games and shows. We will also be making our own puppets.

Science

In science, we will be looking at different materials. We will look at the materials the three little pigs made their houses from, and decide why we think brick was the best. We will also look at alternative materials they could have used to build their houses and decide if there was a way the three little pigs could have made the wooden and the straw house stronger.

We will be using the ipads to conduct research on puppets. The children will use this research in order to design their own puppet to make in class. Incorporated into this topic will be discussions of internet safety and staying safe while online.
