Addition and Subtraction

Money

Following on from the previous term, the children will be moving on from adding and subtracting using physical apparatus to using visual stimulus such as number lines. This will be followed by encouraging mental addition and subtraction. They will also be introduced to the different coins and notes we use in the UK and their different quantities. They will be using these to buy and sell different items, as well as make different amounts.

RE

Belonging, Hinduism and Waiting

We will begin by finishing our topic of Belonging, in which we look at the importance of Baptism. Following this, we will have a Hindu week in which we will look at the story of the Birth of Krishna as well as other significant aspects of the Hindu faith. For the majority of this term, in our RE lessons, we will be looking at Advent, and how this is a time of waiting and preparation for the birth of Jesus.
