There are two ways you can find out if your child's school is closed.

Tune your radio in to 105.4 Real Radio where presenters will be announcing school closures or visit websites www.realradionorthwest.co.uk or www.smoothradionorthwest.co.uk where they will display a list of schools affected by closures. Real Radio broadcasts across the North West on 105.4fm so it's a quick and easy way to listen to school closure details wherever you may be.

Also during extreme frost ice or snow is it not possible or safe to open up the cycle path access to the rear of the school.
