

# English

## Postcards and Letters

In this topic we will be looking at the key features of postcards and letters and will discuss their purposes. Children will be writing a postcard from an imaginary trip to London and writing a letter to the queen.

## Non Chronological Reports

We will look at a selection of non chronological reports and gain an understanding of how they are used. We will be identifying the features of non chronological reports and creating our own non chronological report about the UK.

# Maths

## Addition and Subtraction

Children will learn to add and subtract tens from two digit numbers, add and subtract three single digit numbers, add and subtract two two digit numbers. The children will learn to use these skills in different contexts.

## Multiplication and Division

Children will learn to recall multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.

They will learn to use these facts to solve problems.

# Science

In this unit children will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. They learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive, and apply this in a range of contexts. They make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there, investigating conditions in local micro-habitats and how they affect the minibeasts found within them. This unit allows children to research a range of global habitats and how the living things that live there are suited to their environments, and also provides an introduction to the idea of dependency between plant and animal species.

In this topic we will be looking at the four countries in the UK and their capital cities. We will be learning to use geographical vocabulary and important skills such as using maps, atlases and globes.
