Stories with a fantasy setting

During this unit of work children will read a range of stories with different fantasy settings. They will look at the features of stories with fantasy settings and develop their own fantasy settings for a story.

Newspaper Reports

We will look at the features of a newspaper report. Discuss what newspaper reports are used for. Finally we will use our knowledge of the Great Fire of London to create a newspaper report about the event.

Maths

Measurement: Time

We will be learning to tell the time to the nearest five minutes and will be able to draw hands on a clock to show this. We will also learn to compare and sequence interval of time.

Measurement: Capacity and Temperature

We will be learning to choose the appropriate units to estimate and measure temperature and capacity. Children will also learn to compare and order different capacities and temperatures.

Science

Habitats

In this unit children will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. They learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive, and apply this in a range of contexts. They make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there, investigating conditions in local micro-habitats and how they affect the minibeasts found within them.

Topic

The Great Fire of London

In this topic children will gain an understanding of the story of the Great Fire of London. They will explore life in the 17th Century and look at how London has changed and developed since the Great Fire of London.
