Persuasive writing

Children will look at a variety of persuasive texts and analyse the different techniques that these texts use to persuade. Children will then create their own persuasive text using the skills that we have studied.

Poetry

Children will read the poem questions. They will look at different ways to begin a question and discuss how to correctly write a question. Children will also learn how to include rhyming pairs in a poem. At the end of the unit children will write their own poem about a monster.

Maths

Statistics

Children will learn to construct and interpret simple tally charts, pictograms, block diagrams and tables. Children will be able to ask and answer simple questions about objects in each category as well as asking and answering questions that require them to total and compare data.

Measurement: Capacity and Temperature

We will be learning to choose the appropriate units to estimate and measure temperature and capacity. Children will also learn to compare and order different capacities and temperatures.
