Number and Place Value

Addition and Subtraction

2D and 3D shapes

This term, we will begin by consolidating our knowledge of place value to 20. We will consolidate our learning of more and less and begin to look at counting in 2's. We will continue to investigate our number bonds to 10 through problem solving and reasoning.

Following this, we will be looking and recognising and identifying simple 2D and 3D shapes.

RE

Waiting

This term, we will begin by discussing other experiences and feelings of waiting. We will then discuss Advent and how this is a time of waiting and preparing for the birth of Jesus. We will be learning the nativity story as well as practising and presenting a nativity of our own.

English

The Dark

This term, we will be looking at the book *The Dark* by Lemony Snicket. We will investigate the different features of the text while also making inferences from the pictures and words within. We will be making predictions based on what we have heard so far and will be using this text to write short narratives about their own personal experiences of the dark as well as descriptions of events in the story.

In addition to their main English lesson, the children will receive a daily phonics lesson in which they will learn letter and sound recognition in order to support their reading, alongside a weekly guided reading session.

The UK

Topic

Our topic this term is the UK. The children will be learning about the different countries that make up the UK and the different features of these countries. The children will also have a British Values week in which they will be learning about mutual respect and tolerance.

Computing

We will be using the ipads to conduct research on the UK. The children will use this research in order to answer questions about the key geographical and physical features of the UK. They will also be making short presentations on a different country in the UK.

Science

In science, we will be looking at seasonal changes. As the weather changes from autumn to winter we will be investigating the differences we see and feel and how this impacts on our daily lives and the daily lives of our local creatures and plants.

PE will be on a **Tuesday afternoon and**

Friday morning. The children will be practising throwing and catching as well as other basic skills needed for basketball.
