Dear Parents,

I am now able to provide you with an update for St Luke's Catholic Primary School wider opening provision for all year groups from Wednesday 2nd September 2020.

Breakfast / After school Club and 30 Hour Nursery Provision

Breakfast and After School Club will both re start on Wednesday 2nd September at their usual times.

Breakfast Club from 8am at a cost of £1.50 and Toast Club from 8.30 am at a cost of 50p.

Both will continue to enter through the After School Club entrance. (Please note children will be put into their class groups whilst in these clubs and the School Hall will also be used to support social distancing as recommended in School's Re opening Guidance)

After School Club will be available until 5.30pm Monday – Friday. Please speak to Mrs Lankertis through the school office to book places for this.

30 Hour Nursery Provision places are still available .

Our school office is now open as normal should you need to make contact.

If you have children in other year groups they will be allowed to enter and leave school at the earlier start times. Siblings will not be able to enter through Nursery.

Parents/Guardians access to school premises start of the day

Parents will not be permitted to enter school grounds when dropping the children off in the morning. Staff will be available at the school gate to direct the children.

There are 2m social distancing indicators on the school fence along Shaw Lane for parents and children to use if queuing .

Parents of nursery children will be permitted to queue on the nursery ramp at 2m distancing at the start and end of the nursery school day.

Nursery and Reception staff will communicate with parents about their re start arrangements separately.

Start and End Times

Staggered start and end times have been put into place. **It is important that children are not late.**

Parents/Guardians access to school premises end of the day

Parents will be allowed onto the **infant playground** at 2m distancing . Children will be directed to you individually by their teachers.

Nursery children to be collected at their usual exit.

Reception children to be collected on the Reception playground

Uniform

Children are expected to wear full School uniform.

Lunch arrangements

Parents can purchase a lunch for their child in the normal way. You are also able to provide a packed lunch from home.

Please be assured we have been working extremely hard to put plans and recommendations in place to keep your children and our staff as safe as possible, such as: distance markers around the school, hand washing stations on entrances and exits, Year group bubbles that children will have to stay within and limiting staff they will be in contact with.

Please note that it is once again compulsory for children to attend school from September 2020 and attendance policies and procedures will be followed.

I thank all our parents/carers in advance for the patience and understanding that I know you will show as things evolve over Autumn term.
