Latest Reopening Information

Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to welcoming all year groups back to school tomorrow Wednesday 2nd September 2020. Please find reopening information below. Apologies for the late communication as the latest school guidance was not released to schools until almost 10pm on Friday night.

May I also take this opportunity to congratulate Mrs Friend on the birth of her baby boy and welcome Miss Sutton who will be teaching Year 1 throughout Mrs Friend's maternity leave. Miss Sutton is looking forward to meeting the children of St Luke's and has participated in the staff training days in advance of this.

Hand Gels

Hand gel dispensers have been installed on each entry and exit point in school. Children will be expected to clean hands at these points besides other points around the school including classes, toilets etc.

Class Groups

Children will be completing their school and break activities within their class groups, both inside and outside of the classroom. We have measures in place to keep contact with other class groups and staff to a minimum, including in corridors.

Please be reassured we have planned to make all children's school experience as safe and enjoyable bearing in mind the principles of distancing when possible, grouping and regular washing of hands.

Lunch arrangements

Parents can purchase a lunch for their child in the normal way. You are also able to provide a packed lunch from home. We ask children to bring their packed lunch in a disposable bag with their names on each day in order to limit the amount of things coming to and from school.

Water Bottles

Children can bring their own water bottles into school at the start of the school week. Please make sure the bottles only contain water and are labelled with the child's name. Bottles will stay in school and be sent home on a Friday for cleaning purposes.

Book Bags

Please can children return their book bag to school this week. Book bags will be sent home from school on a Monday and should be brought back to school on Friday. This is to limit the chances of bacteria travelling from house to school or school to house.

Bikes/ Pencil Cases/ Balls etc

Bikes, balls, own pencil cases and own play equipment from home will not be permitted in school until further notice. All classes will have access to school provided play equipment at breaks and lunchtimes.

PE Kits

Children will be allowed to wear their school PE kit on their designated PE days until further notice. PE day information to follow. Please do not send your child into school with their PE bag this week.

Breakfast / After school Club and 30 Hour Nursery Provision

Breakfast and After School Club will both re start on Wednesday 2nd September at their usual times.

Breakfast Club from 8am at a cost of £1.50 and Toast Club from 8.30 am at a cost of 50p.

Both will continue to enter through the After School Club entrance. **(Please note children will be put into their class groups whilst in these clubs and the School Hall will also be used to support social distancing as recommended in School's Re opening Guidance)**

After School Club will be available until 5.30pm Monday – Friday. Please speak to Mrs Lankertis through the school office to book places for this.
