What I should already know

- ◆ 'What happened next?' - after reading a story or looking at other sequences of events, such as getting dressed, planting a seed or making a sandwich. A popular focus is to get children to bring in photographs of themselves as babies and to discuss how they have changed over time.
- ◆ Also, patterns and routines, taking part in events to celebrate time.
- ◆ Toys can be new and used.

Sticky Knowledge

- ◆ The Beatles became a world famous pop group. The four members of the group came from Liverpool and their music is still very popular today.
- ◆ The England football team won the World Cup for the only in 1966 and the final was played at Wembley, London.
- ◆ It was very rare for people to go to a restaurant in the 1960s.
- ◆ Fashion changed greatly in the 1960s with colourful, hippie- style clothes being very popular.
- ◆ The mini car was very popular in the 1960s. The best selling cars were Ford Anglia; Vauxhall Viva; Morris Minor and the Ford Corsair.
- ◆ In the 1960's there was a great space race with Russia and America racing to be first to land on the moon.
- ◆ Toys in the past were different to the toys of today, Recognise the differences between old and new toys.
- ◆ There were only 3 television channels. BBC1 BBC2 and ITV and television programmes were not on all day.
- ◆ There were less cars. Most children played outside in the street.
- ◆ A decade is a period of ten years and recognise decades in chronological order.
