Number and Place Value	1. I can count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, including from any given number
	2. I can read and write numbers to 100 in numerals
	3. I can count in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s.
	4. I can say a number that is 1 less or 1 more than a given number to 100.
	5. I can write numbers to 20 in words
	6. I can identify and represent numbers using objects and pictures including the number line
	7. I understand the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least
Addition and Subtraction	8. I know the signs (+); (-); and (=) and can use them in my work
	9. I can represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
	10. I can add and subtract 1-digit and 2-digit numbers to 20, including 0.
	11. I can solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations
	12. I can solve missing number problems such as $7 = ? - 9$
Multiplication and Division	13. I can solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of my teacher
Fractions	14. I can recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
	15. I can recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
Measurement	16. I can compare, describe and solve practical problems for lengths and heights, eg. long/short, tall/short
	17. I can compare, describe and solve practical problems for mass/weight, eg. heavy /light, heavier than /lighter than
	18. I can compare, describe and solve practical problems for capacity and volume, eg. full/empty, more than /less than
	19. I can compare, describe and solve practical problems for time e.g. quicker, slower, earlier, later
	20. I can measure and record the following: lengths / heights; mass/weight; capacity and volume; time (hours, minutes, seconds)
	21. I can recognise all coins 1p; 2p; 5p; 10p; 20p; 50p; £1 and notes £5; £10; £20
	22. I can name the days of the week and months of the year
	23. I can tell the time to o'clock and half past and can draw hands on a clock face to show these times
Shape	24. I can recognise and name the 2D shapes: circle, triangle, square and oblong
	25. I can recognise and name the 3D shapes: cube; sphere; cuboid; pyramids
Position and Direction	26. I can describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns
