Technical Knowledge and skills

- Use a running stitch and/or an over stitch to join two pieces of fabric together.
- Use a template to cut out appropriate sizes of fabric.
- Develop ideas by putting components together.
- Follow their designs to create their puppets.
- Work safely and sensibly when working with a variety of materials and tools.
- Discuss their finished work and evaluate what could be improved.

Vocabulary

Features	A distinctive aspect of something.
Stitch	A loop of thread or yarn made by a using needle.
Template	A shaped piece of material used as a pattern for cutting out, shaping, or drilling.
Design Criteria	Goals a project must achieve to be successful.
Textiles	A type of cloth.
Decorate	Make something look more attractive by adding extra items to it.
Product	An item that is the result of an action or process.
Evaluate	Make a judgement against a set design criteria.
Develop	Grow or cause to grow because of an action.
Purpose	The reason something is done or created.
Tool	A device used to carry out an action.
