Lesson	Objective/s
Lesson	<ul> <li>Review previous knowledge.</li> <li>Pre-Learn</li> <li>Look at new knowledge organiser</li> <li>To learn about and describe the art of William Morris and give an opinion on his work.</li> <li>To gather and collect examples of William Morris artwork in a sketch book.</li> </ul>
Lesson 2	<ul> <li>To visit the local area to look at different styles of houses.</li> <li>Discuss how you would describe their features.</li> <li>To have an awareness of the variety of colour in the environment.</li> <li>Label pictures from your trip using Phonetic knowledge appropriate for year 1.</li> </ul>
Lesson 3	<ul> <li>To use a sketch book to gather and collect ideas about house fronts</li> <li>To be able make 2D sketches of some of the houses in a local street</li> </ul>
Lesson 4	<ul> <li>To be able to create deeper and shallower marks on polystyrene.</li> <li>To be able to make different patterns using different tools.</li> </ul>
Lesson 5	<ul> <li>To be able to print using created polystyrene printing tiles.</li> <li>To be able to mix paint to create a secondary colour.</li> <li>To use different ways to apply paint.</li> </ul>
Lesson 6	<ul> <li>To use sketches of 2D houses to mark polystyrene to create a house front tile.</li> </ul>
Lesson 7	<ul> <li>To be able to explore and create patterns.</li> <li>To be able to create a foreground and a background.</li> <li>To be able to create a repeated pattern print in the style of William Morris using relief prints of local houses.</li> </ul>
