Lesson	Objective/s
Lesson 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Review previous knowledge.• Pre-Learn• Look at new knowledge organiser• To learn about and describe the art of William Morris and give an opinion on his work.• To gather and collect examples of William Morris artwork in a sketch book.
Lesson 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To visit the local area to look at different styles of houses.• Discuss how you would describe their features.• To have an awareness of the variety of colour in the environment.• Label pictures from your trip using Phonetic knowledge appropriate for year 1.
Lesson 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To use a sketch book to gather and collect ideas about house fronts• To be able make 2D sketches of some of the houses in a local street
Lesson 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To be able to create deeper and shallower marks on polystyrene.• To be able to make different patterns using different tools.
Lesson 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To be able to print using created polystyrene printing tiles.• To be able to mix paint to create a secondary colour.• To use different ways to apply paint.
Lesson 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To use sketches of 2D houses to mark polystyrene to create a house front tile.
Lesson 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To be able to explore and create patterns.• To be able to create a foreground and a background.• To be able to create a repeated pattern print in the style of William Morris using relief prints of local houses.
