Lesson	Objective/s
Lesson 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Review previous knowledge.</li><li>• Pre-Learn.</li><li>• Look at new knowledge organiser</li></ul>

Lesson 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To explore the Indian block-printing technique.</li><li>• To explore some wooden printing blocks and compare them and discuss which share strong resemblance to Indian artwork.</li><li>• To print from a textured surface using wooden blocks that we have explored using printing ink.</li></ul>
Lesson 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To copy some ideas into sketchbooks before creating your own design to make a printing block.</li></ul>
Lesson 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To create an initial sketch in sketch books for your own printing block.</li></ul>
Lesson 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To mark out and cut different depths of cardboard using different methods e.g. scissors.</li></ul>
Lesson 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To transfer initial sketches onto cardboard ready to cut out.</li><li>• To glue cardboard down to create your own block to print.</li><li>• To add string to cardboard to create more detailed patterns.</li></ul>
