Ostinato	A repeated, often rhythmic pattern.
Concerto	Part of a piece of classical music when a solo instrument is highlighted.
Allegro non molto	Not very quickly.
Largo	Very slowly.
Allegro	Fast and joyful.

Presto e forte	Very fast and loud.
Presto	Very fast.
