



## Henry Moore

Lesson	Objective/s
Lesson 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Review previous knowledge.</li><li>• Pre-Learn</li><li>• Look at new knowledge organiser</li></ul>
Lesson 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Research the work of Henry Moore</li><li>• Collect and record visual information and annotate the work of Henry Moore.</li><li>• Sketch out some representations of Henry Moore in sketch books.</li><li>• Look at the drawing, London underground tube shelter perspective 1941.</li><li>• Can you think of some words to describe how the people sheltering from bombs were feeling?</li></ul>
Lesson 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Notice how Henry Moore builds up and overlaps scribbles to create drawings.</li><li>• To learn that cross hatching and scribbling is an effect used by Henry Moore.</li><li>• Cross hatching adds, tone, shade, depth and texture.</li><li>• Use this technique in sketch books by drawing your hand.</li><li>• Add hints of colour using oil pastels to create aspects of light and dark.</li></ul>
Lesson 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Look at Henry Moore sculptures and discuss the differences and similarities of his drawings and his sculptures.</li><li>• Is this abstract or realism? What is the difference?</li></ul>
Lesson 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Your final piece will be a clay sculpture inspired by Henry Moore.</li><li>• Using charcoal/Pencil draw a figure in 3 different positions.</li></ul>
