Technical Knowledge and skills

- Annotating designs.
- Marking and cutting fabric accurately, in accordance with a design.
- Sewing a strong running stitch, making small, neat stitches and following the edge.
- Tying strong knots.
- Decorating a waistcoat - attaching objects using thread and adding a secure fastening.
- Learning different decorative stitches.

What I should already know

- Sewing accurately with even regularity of stitches.

Design a stuffed toy, considering the main component shapes of their toy.

Create an appropriate template for their stuffed toy.

Join two pieces of fabric using a blanket stitch.

Neatly cut out their fabric.

Use appliqué or decorative stitching to decorate the front of their stuffed toy.

Use blanket stitch to assemble their stuffed toy, repairing when needed.

Identify what worked well and areas for improvement.



Sticky Knowledge

To understand that it is important to design clothing with the client/target customer in mind.

To know that using a template (or clothing pattern) helps to accurately mark out a design on fabric.

To understand the importance of consistently sized stitches.

Vocabulary

Annotate	To add notes which explain a plan or design
Fastening	A closing and opening detail on clothing such as buttons, zips and press-studs
Seam	A line along two edges of cloth that are joined or sewn together.
Target Audience	A particular group of people who the product is aimed at.
Target Customer	A particular person who the product is aimed at

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
