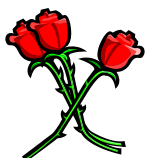
### World Book Day Celebrations

### Mothers' Day

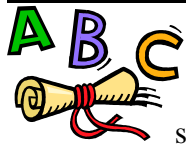
