Timeline

- ullet 7,500 BC the first settlers arrive in the Nile Valley
- 3,200 BC Hieroglyphs are used to keep trade records
- 2,555 BC Giza Pyramids are built for three Pharaohs.
- 2,520 BC The Great Sphinx is built
- 1,539 BC Valley of the Kings starts and pharaohs are buried with their treasures.
- 1,332 BC The 10 year rule of Tutankhamun begins
- \bullet $\,$ 51 BC Cleopatra's reign begins, the Egyptian civilization ends

- ◆ Ancient Egypt was an ancient civilisation of North Africa with many rulers called Pharaohs. It began around 3000BC until 5IBC.
- ♦ The River Nile was essential to life in the deserts of Ancient Egypt.
- ◆ The pyramids were built for the tombs of pharaohs who were mummified and buried with their possessions.
- ♦ Tutankhamen was a pharaoh known as the boy king. His tomb was found in pristine condition in 1922 by Howard Carter.
- ♦ We know about Ancient Egypt because of artefacts that have been discovered by archaeologists.
- The Egyptians were the first civilization to invent writing.
