Lesson 2	To investigate and compare climates and biomes of different regions in North America. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Including geographical features.</li></ul>
Lesson 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To recognise the various time zones of North America and how these compare to other time zones around the world. Children could have a A3 map, sort the time zones they associate with countries, then review. Compare to UK time zone, what is different/ similar?</li></ul>
Lesson 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I can identify physical and human geographical features of my local area. (Fieldwork opportunity)</li><li>• I can identify similarities and differences in the human and physical geography of my local area and a region of North America.</li></ul>
Lesson 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Group activity to persuade others to visit North America using previous investigation.</li></ul>
