Quaver – half a crotchet

### Vocabulary

Graphic Notation

A symbol used to represent a sound.

Motif

A short musical idea.

Ostinato

A repeated, often rhythmic pattern.

Pulse

The steady beat of the music.

Rondo

A music shape with a recurring theme.

Sound Scape

A musical collage of sounds often free flowing without an underlying beat or pulse.

Structure

The shape of a piece of music.
