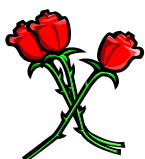
World Book Day Celebrations

IMPORTANT Breakfast & After School Club booking and payment arrangement changes

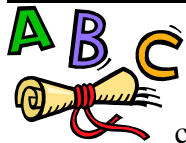
From Sunday 9th March new arrangements will be in place for booking Breakfast & After School Club places. Bookings and payments need to be made in advance via ParentPay. Places are limited therefore it is essential that you book and pay in advance to secure your child's place. As this is a non-profit making service it is essential that payments are made in advance as the school's budget is unable to cover these costs. **After School Club is £6 per day, Breakfast Club is £1 per day.**
