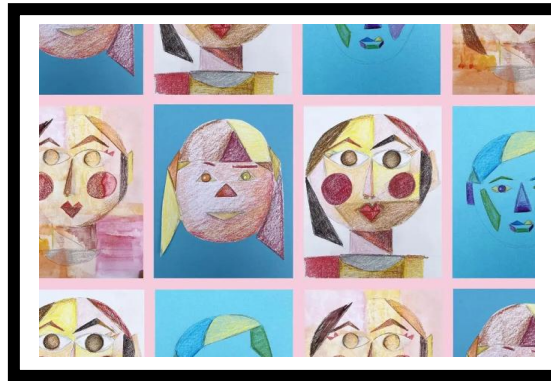
Art

Exploring Line and Shape

Year 1

What I should already know

- The children will have some experiences of looking closely and making observations of objects and art.
- The children have some knowledge of using and manipulating materials and objects to create a planned effect.



Sticky Knowledge

You can draw different types of lines by varying control and pressure, e.g. straight, wavy, broken, lighter, darker etc.

Different materials make different marks.

2D shapes can be used to form the 'bones' of a drawing.

Applying more pressure when drawing, or colouring will give a darker tone.

Technical knowledge and skills

- Develop control when using a wide range of tools to draw, paint, and create crafts.
- Make choices about what materials to use to create the desired effect.

Vocabulary

Artist	A person who makes pictures or other kinds of art.
Control	To be careful and make something do what you want.
Line	A long mark made with a pencil or pen.
Pressure	How hard you press with your hand or pencil.
Circle	A round shape with no corners.
Triangle	A shape with three sides and three corners.
Square	A shape with four sides that are all the same length.
Rectangle	A shape with four sides, two long and two short.
